BPRR-9501 Fuel Cost Recovery Surcharge / % - Based / WTI

Application: BPRR-9501-series applies to linehaul freight rates and charges with respect to exempt traffic and line haul freight rates and charges in contracts, private price quotations or other pricing documents that reference BPRR-9501-series.

In the event the average monthly price of West Texas Intermediate Crude Oil exceeds \$90.00 per barrel, calculated using the daily prices published in the *Wall Street Journal*, Buffalo & Pittsburgh Railroad, Inc. and / or Rochester & Southern Railroad, Inc. may assess a fuel surcharge on all line-haul freight charges as set forth below.

The fuel surcharge percentage may be applied to each shipment having a bill of lading dated on or after the 1st day of the second calendar month following the calendar month of a given WTI Average Price Calculation. The fuel surcharge will change monthly per table below:

The Fuel Surcharge will be 0.4% of the line-haul freight charge for every \$1.00 per barrel, or portion thereof, by which the WTI Average Price exceeds \$90.00. The WTI Average Price for a given calendar month will be determined by adding the daily West Texas Intermediate Crude Oil prices published in the *Wall Street Journal* during a calendar month and dividing the result by the number of days so published in that given month. The result will be rounded to the nearest cent. If *The Wall Street Journal* discontinues publication of the price of West Texas Intermediate Crude Oil, BPRR and RSR will use a suitable substitute source of price or measure.
