



Cape Breton & Central Nova Scotia Railway (CBNS)

runs 245 miles of track from Truro to Sydney, Nova Scotia, and interchanges with CN and SCR.

Primary commodities moving on the CBNS are paper, coal, lumber, petroleum products and chemicals totaling over 12,000 cars per year.

CBNS is part of Genesee & Wyoming Canada (GWCI) which is headquartered in Montreal, Quebec. GWCI includes nine short line railroads and three switching operations in four Canadian provinces and three U.S. states. GWCI also provides rail service to six ports in Eastern Canada.
