



First Coast Railroad (FCRD) is a 32-mile short line railroad that interchanges with CSX Transportation and St. Mary's Railroad. Commodities transported include chemicals, coal, forest products, metals, pulp and paper products and petroleum products. The FCRD was acquired by Genesee & Wyoming Inc. (G&W) in 2005, and is part of G&W's Rail Link Region Railroads, which are headquartered in Jacksonville, Florida. The region includes 21 short line railroads and serves 10 major U.S. ports.

Through G&W's contract rail services subsidiary, Rail Link, Inc., the region provides contracted railroad switching and related customer logistics services to major industrial customers throughout North America. Rail Link, Inc. offers customers a full range of rail-related services, including railcar switching, track maintenance, locomotive and railcar maintenance, in-plant trailer/container drayage, railcar loading/unloading and railcar tracking and monitoring.
