



**Golden Isles Terminal Railroad (GITM)** is a 13-mile short line railroad serving the Georgia Ports Authority and interchanging with CSX Transportation and Norfolk Southern. Commodities transported include automobiles, chemicals, and food and feed products. The GITM was acquired by Genesee & Wyoming Inc. (G&W) in 1998, and is part of G&W's Rail Link Region Railroads, which are headquartered in Jacksonville, Florida. The region includes 21 short line railroads and serves 10 major U.S. ports.

Through G&W's contract rail services subsidiary, Rail Link, Inc., the region provides contracted railroad switching and related customer logistics services to major industrial customers throughout North America. Rail Link, Inc. offers customers a full range of rail-related services, including railcar switching, track maintenance, locomotive and railcar maintenance, in-plant trailer/container drayage, railcar loading/unloading and railcar tracking and monitoring.
