



Massena Terminal Railroad (MSTR) is a terminal switching railroad that was incorporated in 1900 and located in Massena, New York. It interchanges with the CSXT.

Services provided to customers along MSTR's four miles of track line include intraplant switching, track maintenance, car weighing, loading and repair along with traffic coordination. MSTR maintains a certified AAR car repair shop.

MSTR features warehouse space (some of which is heated) which is ideally suited for staging product into and out of Canada. There is also 140 acres of land available for industrial development within three miles of Massena's airport.

Main commodities shipped include alumina, petroleum coke, electrode binder pitch, aluminum ingot, and rolled paper.

NECR is part of Genesee & Wyoming's Northeast Region railroads, which are headquartered in Rochester, New York, and include six railroads in New York, Connecticut, Vermont, New Hampshire, and Pennsylvania.
